BOARD COMMENTS

Mr. Fleming thanked everyone for attending the meeting tonight. Congratulations to the new employees that were hired tonight and I look forward to working with you in the future.

Mr. Fleming said there is something I want to address tonight and that is teacher appreciation. You are appreciated for the effort and work you do. It reflects well on our district and community. Thank you for the personal invitation to the Community Rally but unfortunately I will not be able to attend because of vacation plans.

Mr. Fleming stated there is one thing I take issue with and that is the flyer that was passed around at the parade a couple of weeks ago. It indicated new board members were needed to support teachers, community and programs. The one problem I have is I have never been contacted about my support. That bothers me because it gives the impression I don't support the teachers and community without anyone ever asking me about it. If this flyer was used as a negotiation tactic, then that's a problem for me. I'm very accessible. I am at the ball park with my kids, my phone number is available and if anyone wants to speak with me they can easily get in contact with me. My service on this board is a 24/7 job and if you want to talk to me, I am available. I would like to highlight in the last year and a half there has been great progress made in this district. We have worked together with the community to pass two levies and implement all day kindergarten which are huge accomplishments. The Board has put a lot of heart and soul in implementing a new strategic plan to set the district on a path of excellence now and in the future. We can be fiscally responsible, we can execute programs and hire elite staff to support our students so they have the best opportunity to succeed when they walk out our doors. There is not a person who sits on this board that is sitting here for themselves. We don't do it for pride. We don't do it for recognition. We do it because we love this community. We do it because we want the best for our students. I am a 3rd generation Wildcat graduate. I moved back to Franklin so my children would have the same educational opportunities that was provided to me by being in this community. I supported levies even before I was on the Board because I believe in it. I believe in our staff and I believe this district can succeed so I took it as a personal insult that a flyer was passed out saying I didn't support this community.

Mrs. Raleigh thanked Mr. Fleming and said that is the feeling of the entire board.

Mr. Sizemore said I have had the pleasure of sitting next to Mr. Fleming most of the time he has been on the board and have talked with him about what it means to be on the board and being a servant to the community. You're not going to make everyone

happy all the time but we are responsible to the students first. I assure you Mr. Fleming has taken his role as a board member very seriously. I would hope he wouldn't be driven off the Board because of negotiations tactics. We will continue to prepare for the upcoming school year which is not that far away.

Mr. Knipper welcomed all the new staff. The new staff that has been hired for the upcoming school year have all came with great credentials and high praise.

Mr. Knipper said he was available to speak with anyone with concerns about this school district. If anyone has a question, please feel free to ask me. I feel we will work through negotiations and have an outcome where everyone is happy.

Mrs. Wolfinbarger echoed the sentiments about the flyer. Obviously this is not a glamorous job being on the Board. We are not here for any reason to benefit ourselves. I think by virtue of everyone being here the last couple of meetings has proven that to be the case. Most of the time nobody attends the meetings. We only see people when they are mad or when there is a problem. If there is a problem, by all means let us know because the last thing we want to hear is that we are not supporting the school. We have spent a lot of time in the last year and a half to set goals and to work on implementing new programs.

Mrs. Wolfinbarger announced Andrew Shuppert won the national HVAC competition.

Mrs. Wolfinbarger also announced the Franklin High School theater department has won 25 Day Tony Awards.

Mrs. Raleigh thanked everyone for attending. I would just like to add I was born and raised in Franklin and have dedicated my life to raising other people's children so this is my community unlike most of you sitting here tonight. Most of you in the audience tonight don't live in this community. I was a young mother so I want kids to get the best education available and that's why I'm here. I learned long ago the value of a good education. I'm a common sense person and have learned things the hard way. I just want you to know I appreciate what you do for this district and I do support each and every one of you. This means more to me because it is not just a job but my life. It's so important to have a strong school system because that turns out productive students who go on to succeed in life which is what we want for all of our students.

Mrs. Raleigh congratulated Candy Burress on her retirement. She was a Franklin graduate who started as a bus driver and worked her way through nursing school and we wish her well in the future.
