## **Elementary Summer School**

Students will be working on readiness skills for the next grade level, individualized goals, and STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math) lessons.

### **KINDERGARTEN through GRADE 2**

- Basic Reading skills will be reviewed and reinforced and will gain greater confidence in reading.
- Students will be working on readiness skills for the next grade level in addition to individualized goals.
- Students will also become more proficient in computer and keyboarding skills.
- STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math) activities will be integrated throughout the session.

### **GRADE 3**

Students will focus on the skills that they need to be ready for meeting the Third Grade Reading Guarantee (TGRG) requirements (*no cost to student if he/she still needs to meet the TGRG*).  
At the end of the session, TGRG students will retake the Third Grade ELA test and an alternate test.

### **GRADE 4-6**

- Students will be working on readiness skills for the next grade level in addition to individualized goals.
- Students will receive explicit instruction based on their results of the Ohio State Tests.

### **FEE SCHEDULE**

Scholarships are based on parent eligibility for free/reduced lunch.

**Elementary students who have 90% attendance rate or better during summer school will have 50% of his/her registration fee refunded for summer school for full registration and reduced scholarship.**
